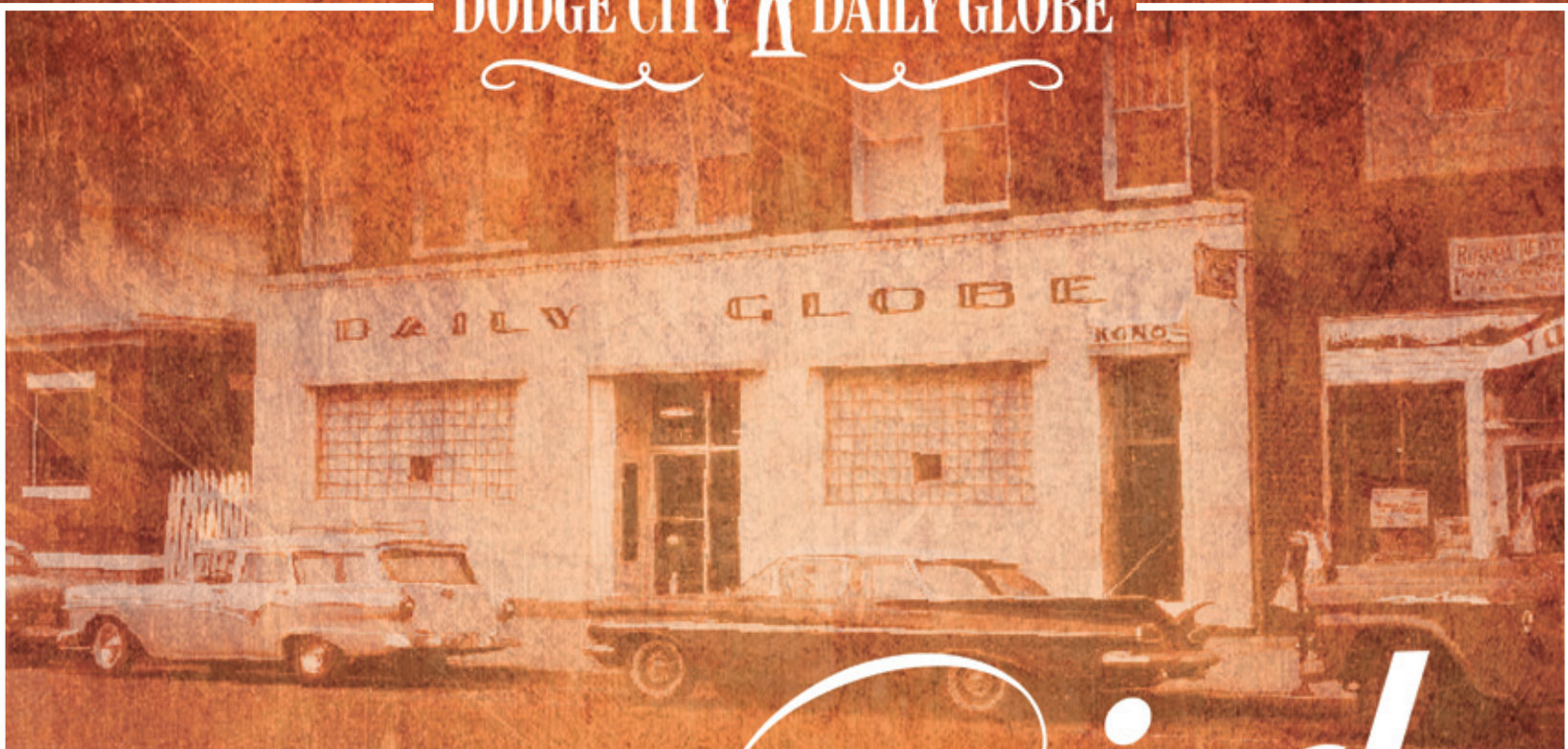

DODGE CITY AMTRAK TRAIN STATION

Dodge City's first depot station was established in 1873. In 1898 the Dodge City Amtrak Train Station was built and has been operating in its current location ever since. Staffed by a group of volunteers dubbed "the Railers," and City employees, the train station facilitates the boarding and de-boarding of passengers while providing helpful information, a warm place to sit and wait, and a complimentary beverage station. It is home to the crown jewel of the Southwest Kansas Theater scene, the Depot Theater Company.

The Santa Fe Depot is the largest railway depot still standing between Kansas City, MO. and Albuquerque, NM. It is the only Amtrak Station between Newton and Garden City and also houses the transit center for Dodge City Public Transportation.

In 2015, over 5,000 people traveled using the Dodge City Amtrak Station!

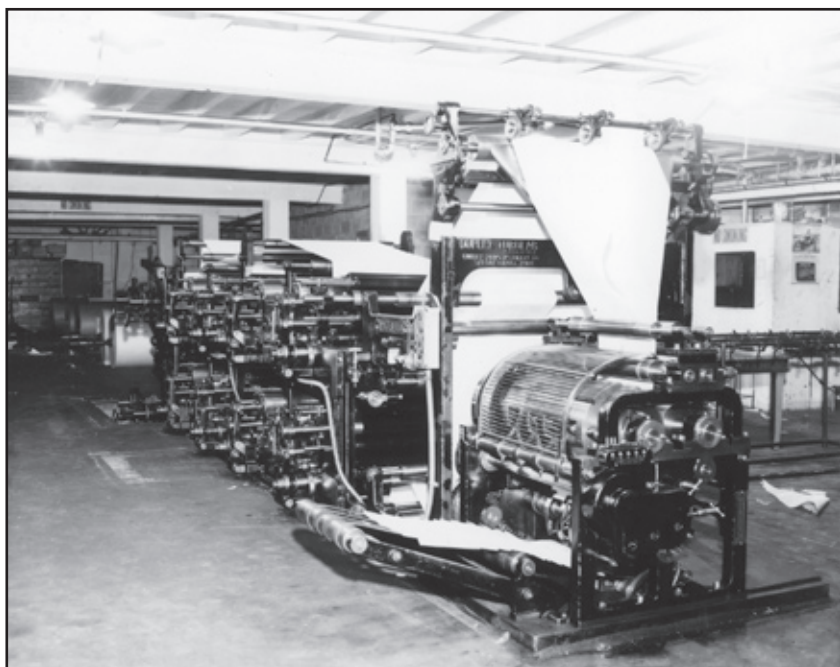
Through a number of changes in ownership and several publisher changes over its 132-year history, The Daily Globe has managed to survive as the official newspaper for Ford County. The Ford County Globe was established by Judge D.M. Frost and W. N. Morphy, with the first issue printed on Jan. 1, 1878. They started with the statement "Stand by the Globe and she will stand by you". In January 1879, a new owner named Lloyd Shinn bought in (Shinn had established the Globe's rival newspaper the Dodge City Times in 1876), only to sell his interest a year later.

On July 15, 1884 Mr. Frost announced the name for the paper would change to the Globe Livestock Journal to keep pace with the rapid strides of stock growers.

Then on Oct. 23, 1889, the Globe-Republican announced the consolidation of the then Globe Live Stock Journal and the Ford County Republican, both Republican newspapers hoping to make a stronger united-party paper which would be a financial success. On Jan. 14, 1892, Frost sold his interest to E.E. Smith, who in turn sold to Shinn, D.W. Moffett and E.H. Madison. A few months after Feb. 1, 1895, records show Mr. Shinn sold the paper to N.B. Klaine. But only seven years later, on June 12, 1902, Mr. Klaine sold the Globe - Republican to W.E. Davis of Meade.



Jess C. Denious of Wichita, who visited Dodge City, was enthusiastic about the future of southwest Kansas and purchased the Tyler's interest on Oct. 1, 1910. The name changed to the Dodge City Globe back in December 1910 and began as a daily paper one year later, on Dec. 11, 1911. W.E. Davis, a state auditor of Kansas was listed as the president of the Globe publishing company until July 3, 1917. Then on July 4, 1917, Mr. Denious was the only person listed as owner until his death in 1953, at which time Martha E. Muncy became involved with management of the Dodge City Daily Globe. Ms. Muncy retained ownership until July 1988, when she sold the paper to Stauffer Communications. Stauffer had ownership until June 1995, at which time the company sold to Morris Communications of Georgia. Morris kept ownership until Oct. 23, 2007, at which time it sold out to the current owners, GateHouse Media.

Since 1898

St. Cornelius' Episcopal Church is situated at 1st and Spruce, which 100 years ago was known as "Holy Hill". It is the oldest church building in continuous use in Dodge City. The Norman style building with its brown stone walls, stained glass windows and square bell tower, is suggestive of the churches of rural England. Several of the people who were instrumental in starting an Episcopal church in Dodge City, were families from England, and they wanted a bit of their heritage to be visible here. Most notable was John J. Summersby, who had attended St. Paul's Cathedral in London and sang in the boy's choir.

In the spring of 1888 a group of citizens who were interested in founding an Episcopal church in Dodge City met in Mr. Summersby's home. The Reverend H. C. Dyer, Garden City, held a Lenten service and plans were laid immediately for the organization of a mission. As time went on, a vestry was elected, a women's guild founded, and the mission was named St. Cornelius. The name seems to be associated with Ft. Dodge, KS. St. Cornelius of Biblical times, was a Roman centurion and was one of the first gentile converts to Christianity. The Episcopal church in Dodge City is the only one so named in the United States.

The mission continued to grow. Over the next 8 years, Mr. Summersby, who was appointed Lay Reader by Bishop Vail, the Episcopal Bishop of Kansas, conducted most of the services. The land the church is built on, was purchased for \$50. The stone for the church was donated and came from an ice house in Dodge City. The ground breaking was Monday, February 7th, 1898. The entire cost was \$1,200. The first service in the



church was held July 17th, 1898 and the building was consecrated September 11th, 1898.

A 20'x40' wing was added to the building in 1915, to be used as a parish house. This provided a meeting room, space for Sunday school and a tiny kitchen. A much needed parish house was completed in 1962 and the old parish house became the north transept of the church.

St. Cornelius' Episcopal Church was a mission until December 3rd 1946 when it gained Parish status. Since becoming a parish, there have only been 4 Rectors in 67 years! The mission priest at the time, the Reverend Rudolph W. Treder, became the first Rector of St. Cornelius' Episcopal Church, serving from 1938 to 1977.

St. Cornelius' Episcopal Church has been proclaiming God's

“You see, no Catholic parish is complete without a parish school. We find it is awfully hard to hammer religion into the hard heads of adults. They are much too occupied with material problems, of one kind and another. Childhood is the time for education and religion is distinctly a matter of education.” Father John M. Handy, as quoted in the Dodge City Journal September, 1915. Sacred Heart Cathedral School opened in September of 1916 in the remodeled old church. Three sisters of St. Joseph taught the 72 students in two classrooms. Because of rapidly increasing enrollment, four more classrooms, an auditorium and rectory were added in 1929. Later in 1949, the school added six classrooms and then an auditorium in 1954.

For 100 years Sacred Heart has challenged students to develop the knowledge, skills, and work habits needed to excel. A high value is placed on creating an environment of respect, self-discipline, and good behavior. Over the century Sacred Heart Cathedral School has given Dodge City children a varied and academic rich curriculum with a strong foundation in faith and the tools needed to become good citizens. 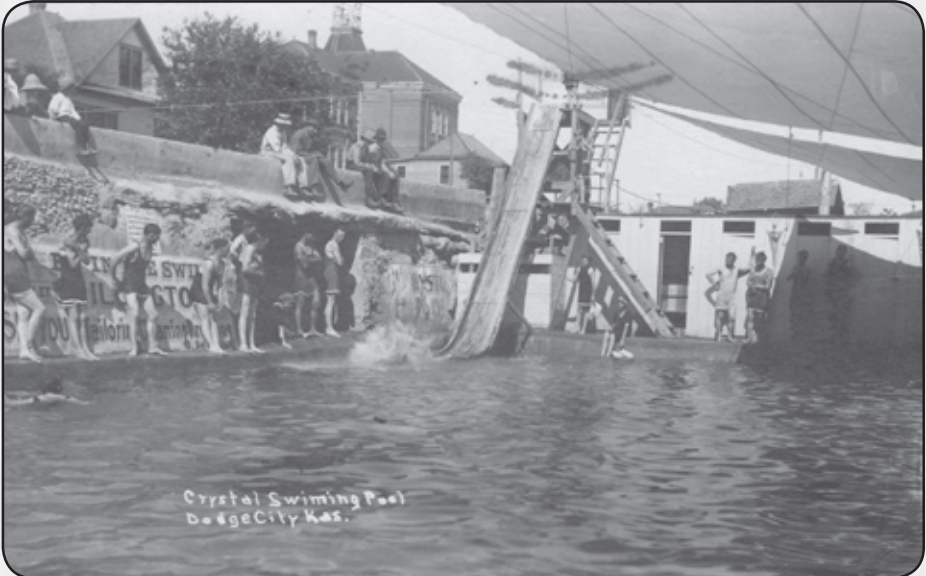
Since 1916

As early as 1916, municipal swimming pools have been a source of entertainment for Dodge City residents. The Hayes Swimming Pool (some referred to it as the Crystal Swimming Pool) was located in the 600 block of West Chestnut St. (now known as Wyatt Earp Blvd. where Montana Mikes is located). The pool was 75-100 ft. long and 25-30 ft. wide, built into a side of a hill.

The Wright Park pool was dedicated on July 1, 1924. The large size pool was 280 ft. by 140 ft. The State Board of Health made an edict that the city must replace or repair the old pool by June 1960. Voters defeated a proposal to issue \$230,000 in bonds for a new swimming pool. Repairs were then made that lasted until April 1975 when it was torn down.

On November 7, 1978, a majority of the electors voted to support the building of a new swimming pool. The construction of the pool was completed in 1980 on 1st Ave. across from the Civic Center. The pool was permanently closed at the end of the swim season in 2015.

Following efforts to develop a new aquatic facility beginning in 2000, and again in 2005, the City of Dodge City passed a resolution in 2013 proposing to the Community Facilities Advisory Board (CFAB) that a regional aquatics facility be approved as a "Why Not Dodge" project. After CFAB approval, the Joint City and County Commissions approved the project on March 31, 2014. The \$12.3 million dollar destination aquatics park will be known as the Long Branch Lagoon and will feature multiple modern amenities including a lazy river, signature slides and wave pool along with theming to tie into the area's western heritage. The park will be opened for the 2016 swim season.



Since 1928

In 1933, with just \$7, A.J. (Amil) Ross started up a small sheetmetal and plumbing shop in a garage in Great Bend. In 1943 he moved the business to 107 East Trail, Dodge City, KS. The name of the company was Ross Heating and Plumbing. The shop had about 5 total employees, but did considerable plumbing and furnace work.



In 1948 A.J. Ross purchased a larger building at 300 1st street, this allowed the company to have a larger inventory and more employees. A short time later A.J. Ross brought in a son, Robert, as a partner. Later Robert (Bob) assumed total ownership, adding more employees to take care of the necessary furnace and air conditioning service.

November 1977, Ross Heating and Plumbing was sold to Ray and Mary Omo and the company was re-named Ross-Omo Inc. Ross-Omo Inc. continued to operate at 300-1st street until 1982 when they relocated to the present location, 309 E. Trail. A short time later, the company name was changed to Ray Omo Inc. Plumbing, Heating, and Air Conditioning. Ray and mary Omo continued to operate the company until June 1st, 1995

Long time employees, Tim Wheaton, Terri Omo, and Gary Schmidt bought Ray Omo Inc. on June 1st, 1995. Gary passed away in 2004 and now the company is solely owned by Tim Wheaton and Terri Omo.

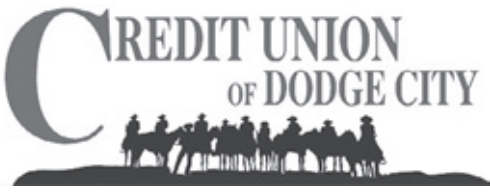

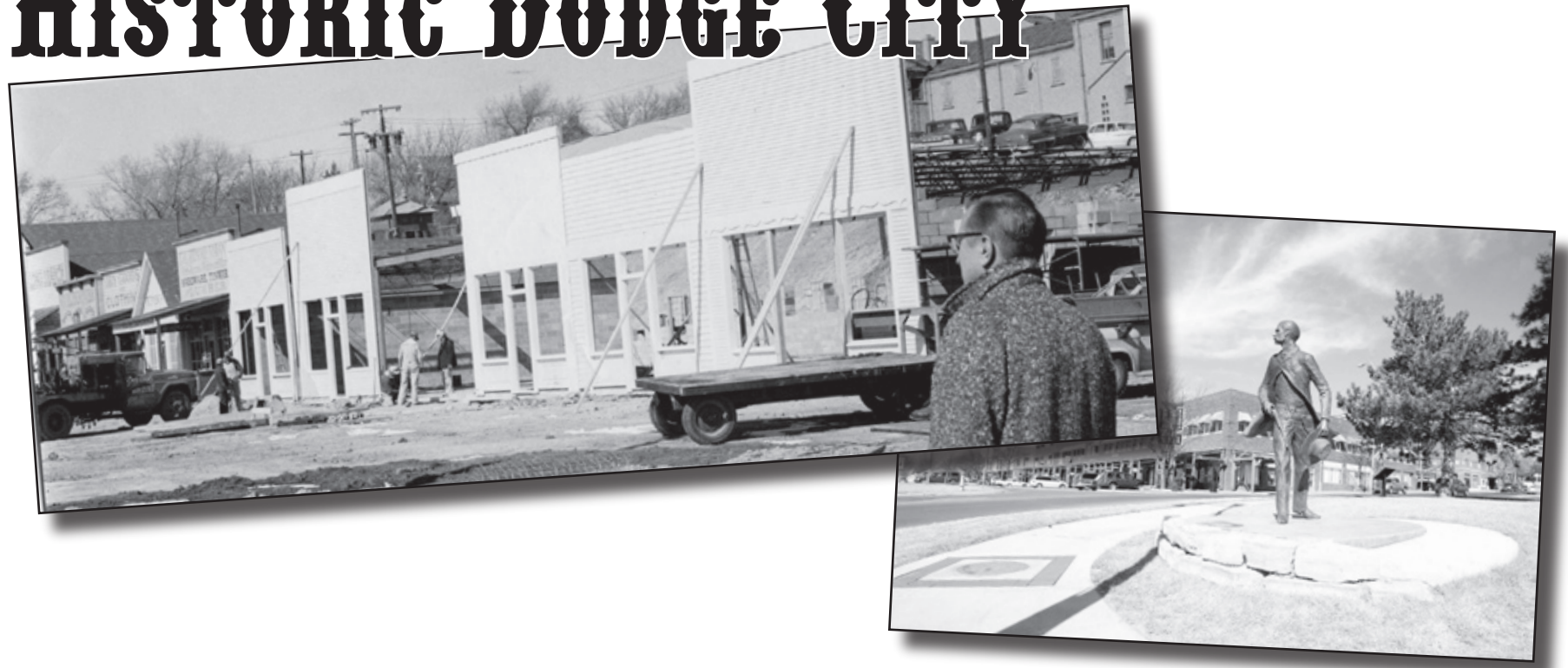

In 1946 a small diner, the "Coney Island," was opened at this address. The Coney Island became a popular place for citizen's of Dodge City and Southwest Kansas. In the next 25 years the building and business increased about 3 times it's original size.

In 1971, Clation (Kate) and Lorene Bradfield purchased the Coney Island, changed the name to "KATE'S," and the tradition of good food and cold drink's continued, and again the business and building increased in size.

In 1982 Kate and Lorene's daughter and son-in-law, Cheryl and Butch Pollington, took over the operations of Kate's, and again the business and building increased in size.

In 2000 Kate's was sold to Riley Skaggs, who is the current owner. Riley has now turned over operations to his daughter Carla and son-in-law Derrick. Kate's is just as popular today as it's always been, if not more so. The business has increased, but there is no more room to expand the building, so it can become very hectic at lunch and dinner time, but we try hard to make it worth the wait.

Hawley Brothers was started in February 1946 in Dodge City by Clifford and Norman Hawley. The Hawley Brothers were raised in Manitoba, Canada and moved to Chicago with their mother in the early 1930's. They both joined the U.S. Army Air Corp in WW II. Cliff was stationed in Dodge City and Norman was stationed back East. After the war the brothers were discharged from the Army and were looking for a new opportunity. Cliff liked Dodge City and they decided to move here and started a venetian blind business making and selling blinds. They moved their mother from Chicago and she worked for her sons in the business.

By the 1950's the business had grown to include storm windows and doors, awnings, railing, patio covers and other home improvement products. Norman left in 1956 to work for the CAA at the Dodge City Airport and Cliff continued to run the home improvement business as Hawley Brothers. In 1965 Cliff started assembling Winnebago pickup toppers in the awning shop. One thing led to another and in 1966 Cliff ordered three Winnebago motorhomes to sell.

The RV business started slowly but soon grew to be a major part of the Hawley Brothers business then known as Hawleywood RV Center. Cliff's son Bill worked in the window business from 1956-1964 while in school. After college Bill worked as a process engineer in a Kansas City factory and returned to Dodge City in 1973 to help run the business. Bill and Karen Hawley purchased the business in 1981 from Cliff and Dorothy and closed the original window business in 1986 to devote full time to the RV business. Bill and Karen bought 132 acres across from the airport and built a new facility known today as the Hawleywood RV Ranch. Today the dealership is the oldest Winnebago dealership in the United States.

that was what was irritating my back. The back pain kept getting more severe, then eventually started causing pain down the back of my legs. At this point, I couldn't even put on my shoes.
